CDCNSW have informed school that there will be significant changes to buses travelling between Epping station and BHHS due to long term road works being undertaken to upgrade the road bridge located over **Epping** Station. Many direct or express buses between BHHS and Epping Station will be cancelled. Students are being directed to take the Metro between Epping and Castle Hill. Extra bus services have been added for travel between BHHS and Castle Hill (both to the bus stop outside of Baulkham Hills TAFE and to the bus stop on Windsor Road). These changes will come effect Monday into on **December** and can be found in detail at

Career Planning Resources

Here is a list of great resources that students and parents can access to help with their career planning, with some explanations about what they are:

https://myfuture.edu.au/assist-your-child This site was made to help students research their future options and it has a parents and carers section so you can help them too. The link goes straight to that parents' page. It is a collaboration between all the Departments of Education in all Australian States. Students can start at the Career Profile to learn more about what might suit them individually, and you can go as far as finding out about what individual workers/jobs do, and everything in-between. Students use their education login to access this site, but some parts are available to everyone, and you can sign up with a personal email address.

https://www.courseseeker.edu.au/ This is a site where you can search for university courses and their entry requirements. You can set filters to round down the options to find the best courses for you.

https://www.compared.edu.au/
This site allows you to compare the same courses at different universities. It is based on a large survey of current and graduated university students and asks about everything from their view on their skills development through to their graduate salaries. I encourage everyone to go into this with an open mind - even though many of our students choose UNSW almost by default, it's not always the best option for everyone.

https://www.jobsandskills.gov.au/ This is a site made by and for the Federal Government to understand the workforce needs of the Australian economy. It's a good place to go to find out how in-demand different industries and jobs are, the areas where that demand exists, and stats/info about what they do. When students ask me if there are jobs in an industry, the first place I go is their Jobs and Skills Atlas. It does a load of other great stuff too, including a national skills shortage list and industry growth projections over 5-10 years.

School Student Travel

School student travel information for parents and students

NSW GOVERNMENT

School Travel Passes

Applications are now open for 2025 School Student Transport Scheme (SSTS) travel.

Students in the Opal network applying for an Opal card (including a Term Bus Pass) for the first time will receive their School Opal card at their nominated postal address from mid-January 2025.

Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass but have not yet applied need to apply or update their details as soon as possible.

In the Opal network, students should travel with a Child/Youth Opal card until they receive their valid School Opal card. If outside Greater Sydney, parents should contact their <u>local</u> bus operator to discuss their travel needs.

Students living in rural and regional areas will receive their travel pass from their nominated transport operator. It may be issued via their school or be sent directly to them at home.

Note: some rural and regional operators do not issue travel passes. Students/parents should confirm with their nominated operator if they do not receive a pass.

Terms of Use

Students using School Opal cards must tap on and tap off in line with the Opal terms of use.

This includes travel within the approved times between 6.30am and 7.00pm from Monday to Friday on school days only. Students must use their Child/Youth Opal card for any travel outside these times.

All students are required to comply with the <u>Student code of conduct</u>. The code of conduct aims to ensure the safety and well-being of school children and other passengers. It is important that parents ensure their child is aware of this, as failure to comply with the code of conduct can result in a suspension from travel.

Travel Concession Cards

For Year 10 to Year 12 Students

Please come to the office to pick up your travel concession card for students 16 years and over.

To be used with a child opal card not the school opal card.
